The following is what is ACCEPTABLE and NOT ACCEPTABLE in our Single Stream Recycling:

**PLASTIC:** Bottles and Containers #1 To #7 Only  
**NO** Plastic Toys, Swimming Pools, Ornaments, Trash Cans, Hangers, Fencing, Flat Pieces Of Plastic, Or Plastic Bags.

**GLASS:** Clear & Colored Glass Jars & Bottles ONLY.

**CANS:** Aluminum, Steel and Bi-Metal Food and Drink Cans ONLY.

**PAPER:** Newspaper, Junk Mail, Office Paper, Cardboard Egg Cartons & Cereal Boxes ONLY.  
**No Styrofoam of Any Kind in Recycling.**  
**No Car Parts in Recycling: No Rotors, Bumpers, Fenders, Etc.**  
**Corrugated Cardboard Boxes Must Be Flattened & Tied Or They Will Be Tagged & Left.**

**BRUSH:** All Brush Must Be 3' Or Less In Length, Tied And Less Than 40 Pounds Each Bundle.  
**No Grass Or Leaves Are To Be With The Brush. Brush Consists Of Twigs And Weeds Only!**  
**NO PLASTIC BAGS ARE TO BE USED IN BRUSH; THEY WILL BE TAGGED AND LEFT.**
