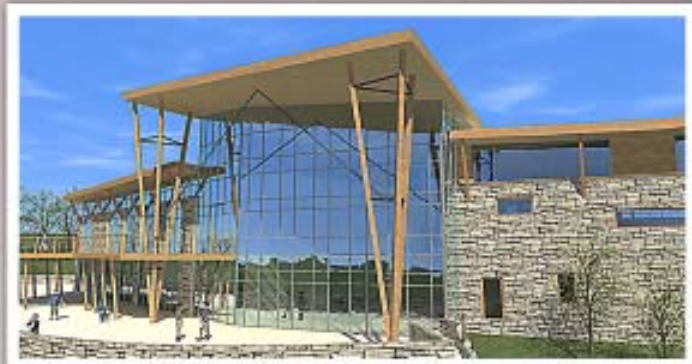

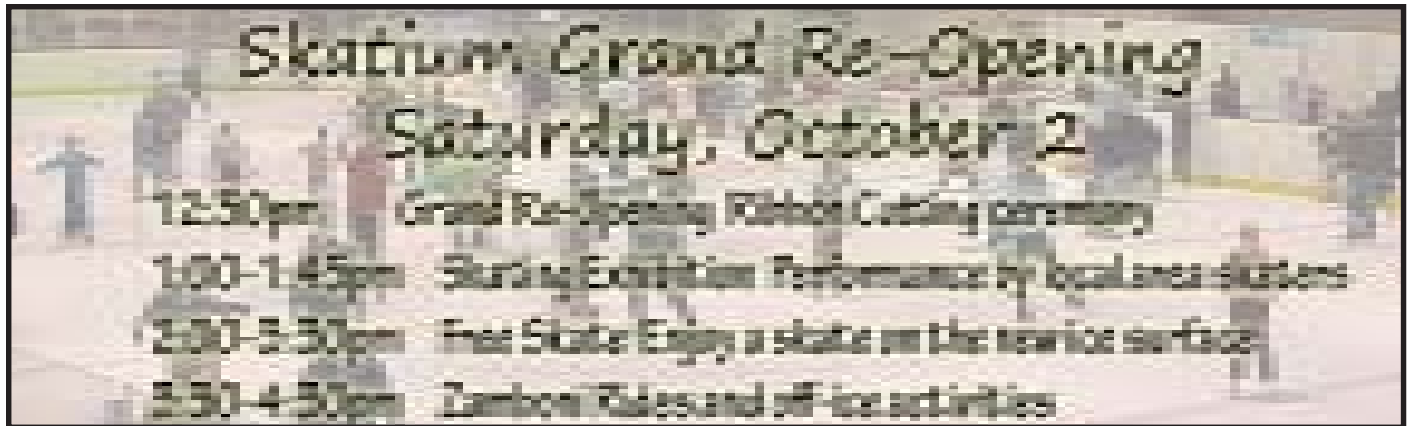

# Community Park Haverford Reserve Update

## Community Recreation/Environmental Center

In June, the Board of Commissioners approved the architect’s Design Plans for the Community Recreation/Environmental Center. Bid documents are scheduled to go out in October or November. Groundbreaking on the 35,000 sq. ft. facility will most likely take place in December or January.



## Geothermal Grant Acquired

In addition to the \$1,000,000 in economic redevelopment grants already acquired from the Governor’s Office of the Budget with the assistance of our State Representative and State Senator, the Township was successful in acquiring a \$300,000 grant from the Pa Department of Energy to fund a geothermal system for the Community Center. These funds along with the Haverford Reserve funds will pay for construction of the facility. In addition, the geothermal system will greatly reduce the carbon footprint and save \$2,000,000 in energy cost over the next 30 years.

## Dog Park

Progress on the Dog Park continues. The park is scheduled to open in November (see page 13). A ‘Friends’ meeting will be held in late October to help in planning the operation of the park.

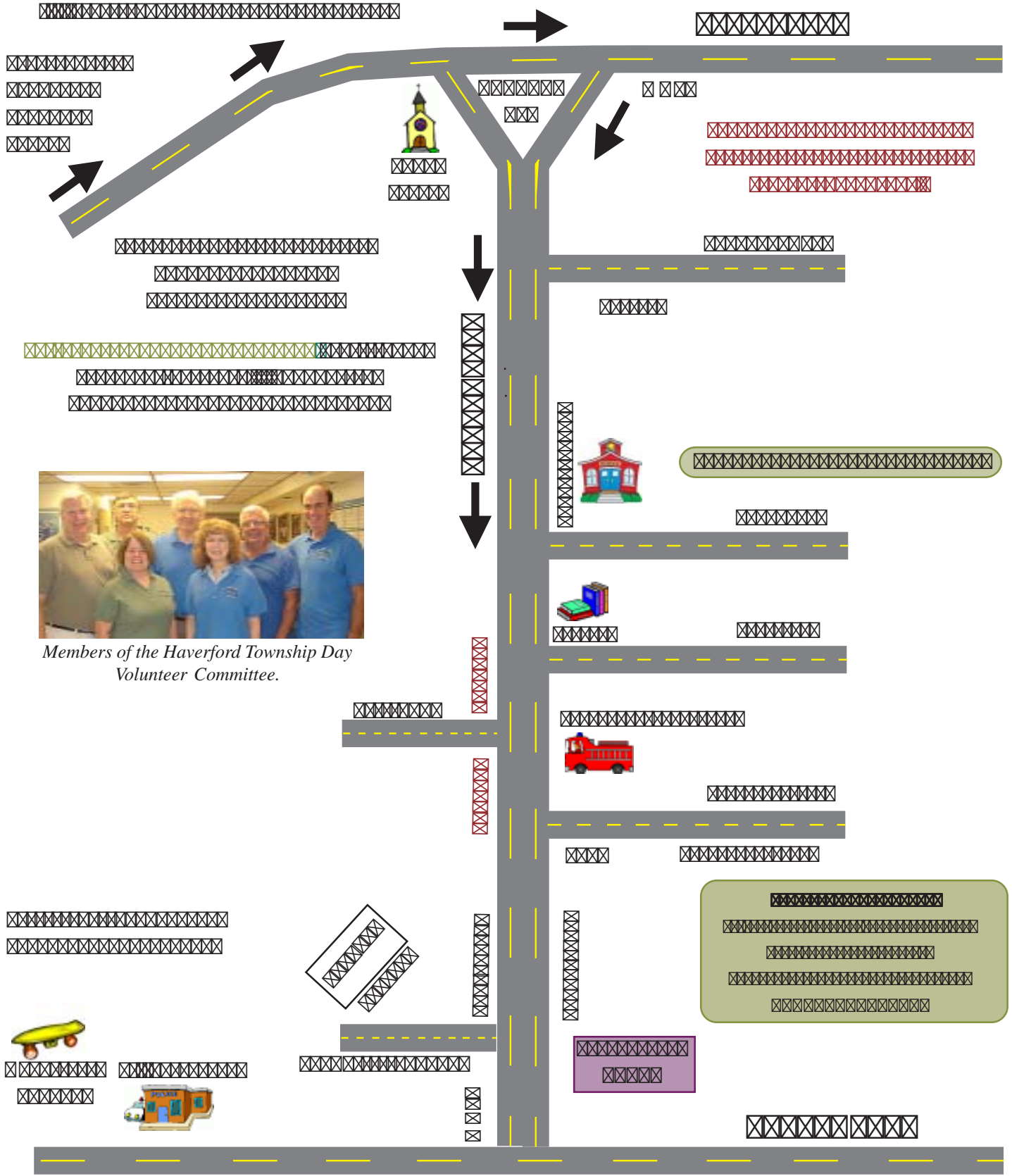
