In March, the Commissioners approved the schematic design for the Community Center. The building will be a LEED certified green building which will save energy, reduce operating costs, and be a model for the township's Climate Action Plan. It will have an outdoor porch and will serve as a community gathering spot.

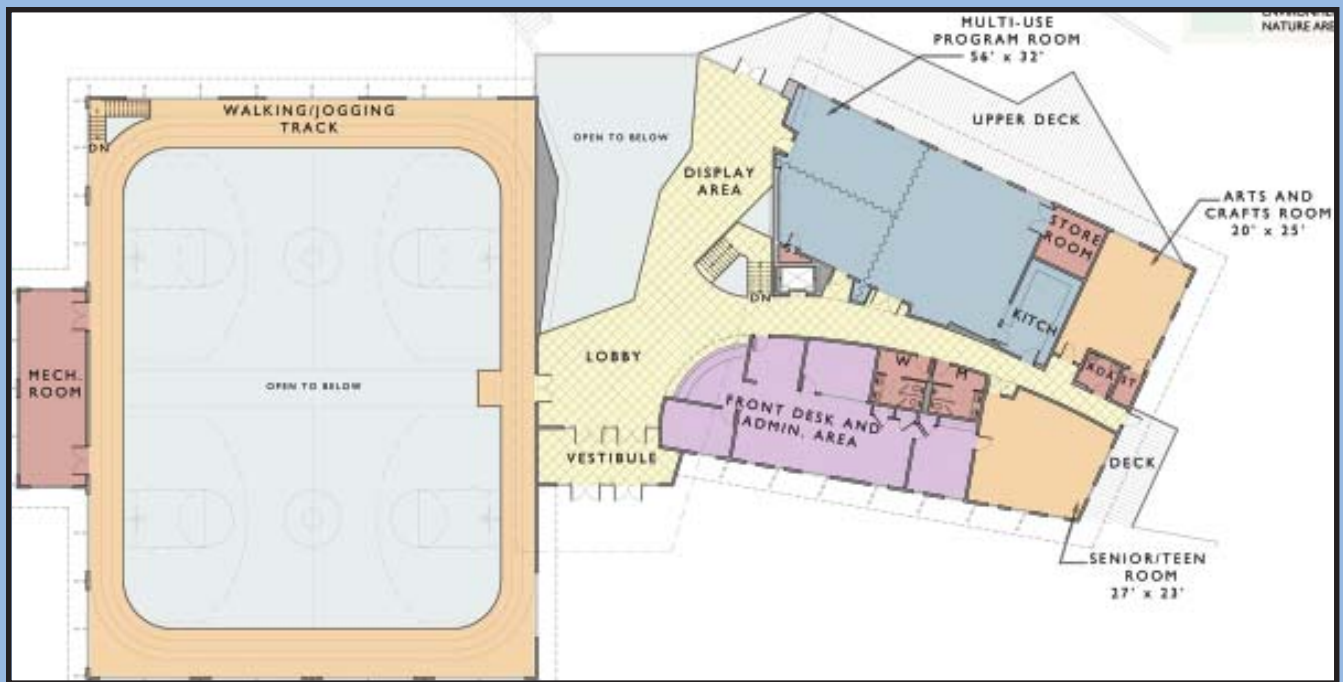
Fence posts will continue to be routed until all 1100 are sold and installed. We will be having a Grand Opening as soon as the ground cover is installed.

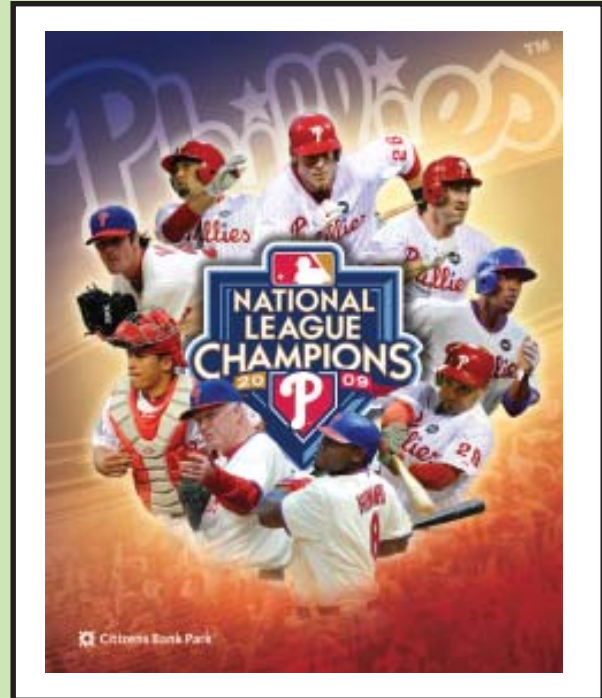

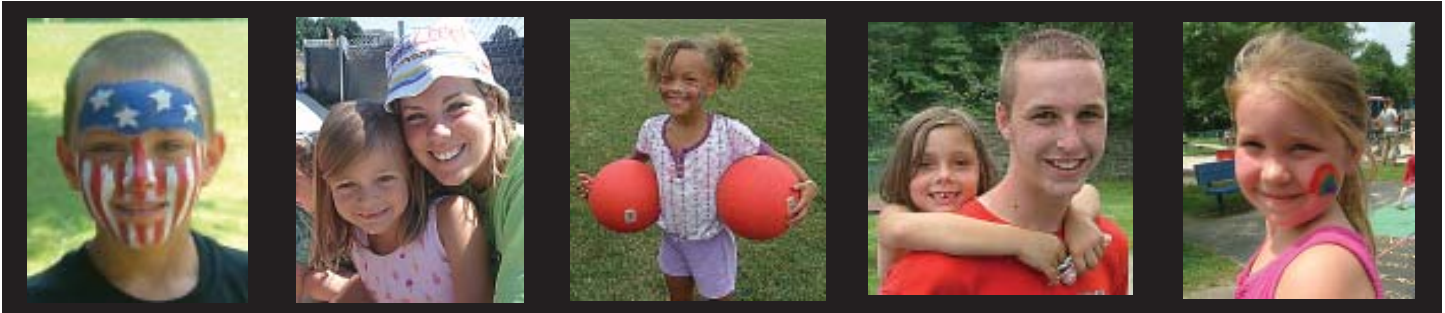
