## Top 5 Questions about the Community Recreation Environmental Center

### 1) When will it open?

Construction is scheduled for completion in April 2012 and the building open to the community in May 2012.

### 2) What will the CREC include?

The CREC includes a double gym, walking track, wellness area, multi-use room, environmental center.

### 3) Why is there no pool?

The agreement with the YMCA stipulates that the township would not include a pool because of the Y's pool.

### 4) What is the mission of the CREC?

The CREC will be geothermal powered and serve to educate and promote wellness, environmental stewardship, and be a model of inclusion and community involvement.

### 5) Will there be fees?

There will be fees related to programs, leagues and rentals; but no memberships, much like the Skatium.

## Grants Acquired for Community Park Development

- \$50,000** -National Fish and Wildlife Foundation for an ecological inventory
- \$1,500,000** -Economic Development Grant for construction of the CREC
- \$300,000** -Pa Energy Authority for geo-thermal at CREC
- \$5,000** -from PECO for trail development
- \$12,000** -from Pa Horticulture for fighting invasive species and planting native trees.

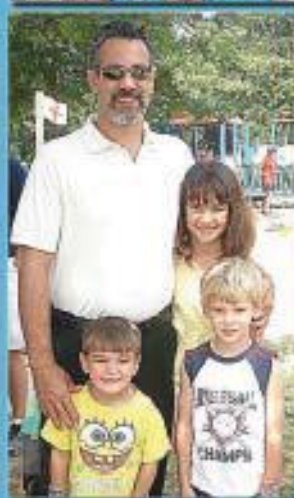
