Community Recreation & Environmental Center

Construction continues on-budget and on schedule for the CREC. The 40 geothermal wells are complete. The 35,000 square foot building which includes a double gym, walking track, wellness area, multi use rooms and environmental education area is scheduled to open in late May. Haverford Township received almost 2 million in grant funds to supplement the Haverford Reserve proceeds to cover all construction costs.

Freedom Playground

The 3rd Annual Touch-A-Truck was held on Saturday, July 30. Thanks to over 1,400 participants and a great effort from the Freedom Playground Committee, we raised a net of \$9,400.



Thanks also to all the volunteers who brought their vehicles. The funds will be used to install shade canopies. More artwork was completed at the tallest structure; Independence Hall and at the Ben Franklin Post Office near the rock wall. The last piece of play equipment was installed this summer, and everyone seems to love the water misters turned on for the first time in June. Thanks to Parks & Recreation for all their help with these completions! We are putting on the finishing touches to the playground so let us know if you want a fence post or brick paver.
