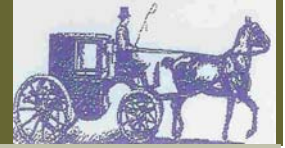

Paddock Park Improvement Survey Results

More than 80 households responded to the survey conducted in the Fall about Paddock Park and provided insights on what could be improved. The results of the survey have been shared with Fourth Ward Commissioner, Dan Siegel, and with the Haverford Township Recreation Department.

In summary, 48% of respondents said that Paddock Park was "one of the best" in Haverford Township," but just slightly more -- 49% -- said it was just average. Working with township representatives on projects such as permanent restroom facilities, rainwater management and improved landscaping, we hope to change this equation.

Thanks to everyone who responded to the survey. There were many great ideas shared, and we hope to incorporate as many as possible with the resources we have available, including our community's own time and talents.
